

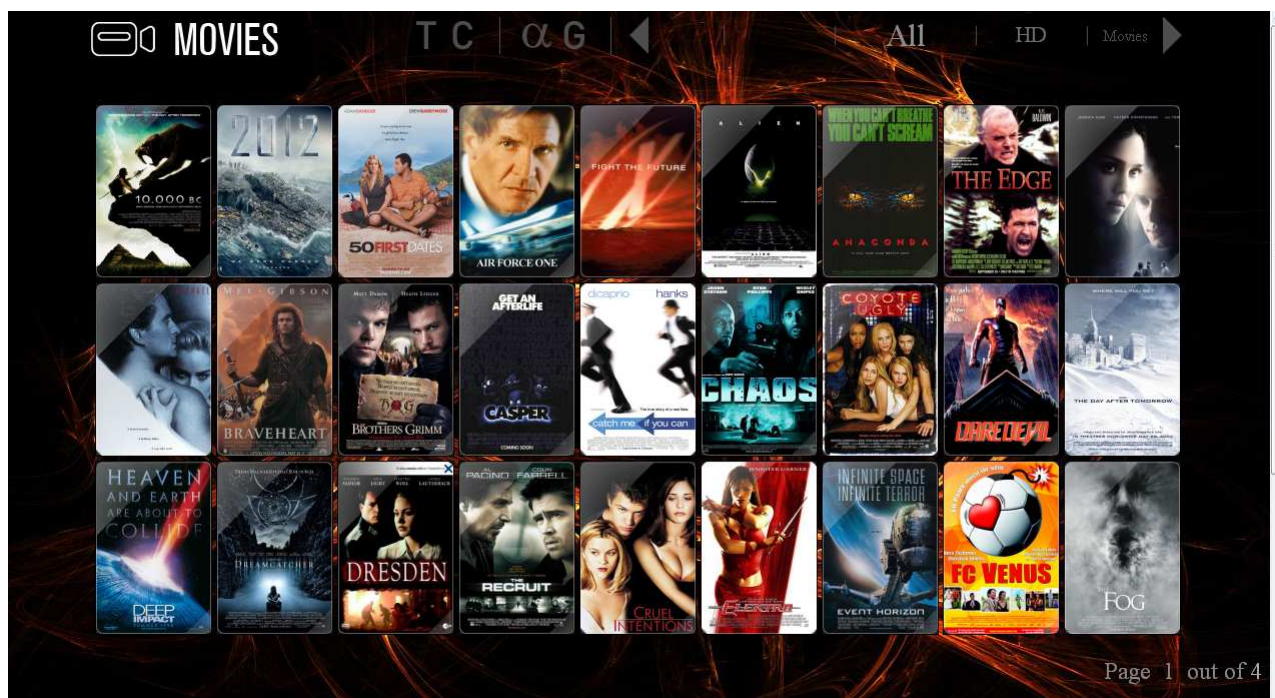
**Please read this document carefully.**  
**The answers of the most questions to my all-in-one / skin package named**  
**"SabishGT" you'll find here.**

**Let's start:**

## ----- INDEX OPTIONS -----

**NOTE! The easiest way to change the index views is to copy the files named skin.properties, skin-user.properties and skin-options.xml from the options folder of your choice to the root folder of the skin!**

**I want this index wall, what's the name and what do I have to change to enable it?**



This is the standard rounded corners view. To enable check the following options:

skin-options.xml:

```
<xsl:variable name="roundedcorners">true</xsl:variable>
```

skin.properties:

```
##### THUMBNAILS CONTROL #####  
  
# 3 ROWS - works for 'true' or 'false' or 'box' for "roundedcorners" in skin-options.xml  
mjb.nbThumbnailsPerPage=27  
mjb.nbThumbnailsPerLine=9  
thumbnails.width=117  
thumbnails.height=174  
  
# 2 ROWS - works for 'true' or 'false' or 'box' for "roundedcorners" in skin-options.xml  
#mjb.nbThumbnailsPerPage=12  
#mjb.nbThumbnailsPerLine=6  
#thumbnails.width=176  
#thumbnails.height=261
```

All other lines in the part named "Thumbnail Control" must be disabled by "#" at the beginning of the line.

Everytime you switch between the index views, you should set this in your moviejukebox.properties and rerun YAMJ

```
mjb.forceIndexOverwrite=true  
mjb.forceThumbnailsOverwrite=true  
mjb.forceBannersOverwrite=true
```

### **What about 2 rows or 4 rows of covers?**

Pound/unpound the proper lines with “#” in the skin.properties file.

### **Can I have box covers in this view?**

Yes, by setting this:

```
<xsl:variable name="roundedcorners">box</xsl:variable>
```

### **And no boxes and no rounded corners?**

Sure:

```
<xsl:variable name="roundedcorners">false</xsl:variable>
```

Take care that you disable this setting in the skin-user.properties too:

```
##### ROUND CORNERS THUMBNAILS CONTROL #####  
#thumbnails.roundCorners=true  
#thumbnails.cornerRadius=15
```

### **What about a list view with movie names on the left side and cover on the right side?**

Try these settings:

skin-options.xml:

```
<xsl:variable name="roundedcorners">list</xsl:variable>
```

skin-properties:

```
# LIST - works *only* for 'list' for "roundedcorners" in skin-options.xml  
mjb.nbThumbnailsPerPage=17  
mjb.nbThumbnailsPerLine=2  
thumbnails.width=367  
thumbnails.height=544
```

All other lines in the part named “Thumbnail Control” must be disabled by “#” at the beginning of the line.

## I´ve seen AEON Movie Wall with a POP-UP view, is it possible?

Yes change the following settings:

skin-options.xml:

```
<xsl:variable name="roundedcorners">awesome</xsl:variable>
```

skin-properties:

```
# 3 ROWS POPUP - works *only* for 'awesome' for "roundedcorners" in skin-options.xml
mjb.nbThumbnailsPerPage=27
mjb.nbThumbnailsPerLine=9
thumbnails.width=160
thumbnails.height=237
```

All other lines in the part named "Thumbnail Control" must be disabled by "#" at the beginning of the line.

## What are the settings for 2 row pop ups?

skin-options.xml:

```
<xsl:variable name="roundedcorners">awesome2</xsl:variable>
```

skin-properties:

```
# 2 ROWS POPUP - works *only* for 'awesome2' for "roundedcorners" in skin-options.xml
mjb.nbThumbnailsPerPage=12
mjb.nbThumbnailsPerLine=6
thumbnails.width=218
thumbnails.height=323
```

All other lines in the part named "Thumbnail Control" must be disabled by "#" at the beginning of the line.

## Can I have rounded corners for Pop-Up view?

Yes with the new YAMJ versions you can have rounded corners by this setting in the **skin-user.properties**

```
##### ROUND CORNERS THUMBNAI LS CONTROL #####
thumbnails.roundCorners=true
thumbnails.cornerRadius=25
```

## Do I have more options for the index view?

To center the movie title with roundedcorners options "true", "false" and "box" you can set in skin-options.xml:

```
<xsl:variable name="index-centertitle">true</xsl:variable>
```

This will not work with awesome or awesome2 and will not work for tvshow banners view!

The following option adds a texture behind the titles on indexes:

```
<xsl:variable name="index-titlebackground">true</xsl:variable>
```

With the setting:

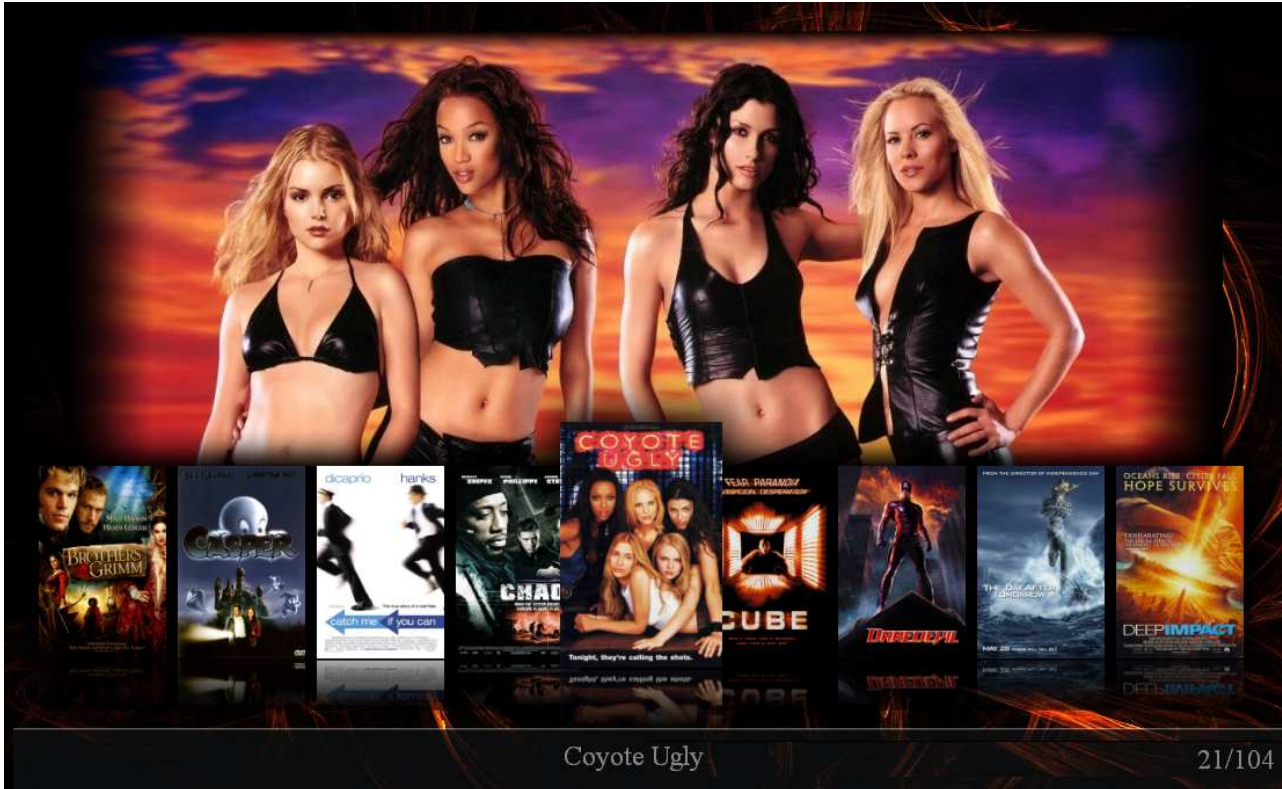
```
<xsl:variable name="index-cleanview">true</xsl:variable>
```

the top menu bar won't be shown by default. You can toggle it on/off by pressing the MENU/TAB key.

----- REDEFINED INDEX WALL -----

I've heard from the "Redefined-look-a-like" index option, what is it and how can I enable it?

That's my "Redefined" mod for AEON Movie Wall:



To use it, you have to set in skin-options.xml:

```
<xsl:variable name="roundedcorners">redefined</xsl:variable>
```

the following setting you have to do in the **skin-user.properties** not skin.properties:

```
### REDEFINED - works *only* for 'redefined' for "roundedcorners" in skin-options.xml ###
```

```
mjb.nbThumbnailsPerPage=999
```

```
mjb.nbThumbnailsPerLine=9
```

```
mjb.nbTvThumbnailsPerPage=999
```

```
thumbnails.reflection=true
```

```
posters.reflection=false
```

```
thumbnails.width=128
```

```
thumbnails.height=194
```

```
thumbnails.reflectionHeight=25
```

```
thumbnails.reflectionStart=0.0
```

```
thumbnails.reflectionEnd=100.00
```

```
thumbnails.opacityStart=30.0
```

```
thumbnails.opacityEnd=100.0
```

```
### REDEFINED END ###
```



**ATTENTION!** Every time you don't want to use "redefined", disable the lines by setting "'#" at the beginning!

### How to enable the sliding function for redefined?

Use skin.options.xml:

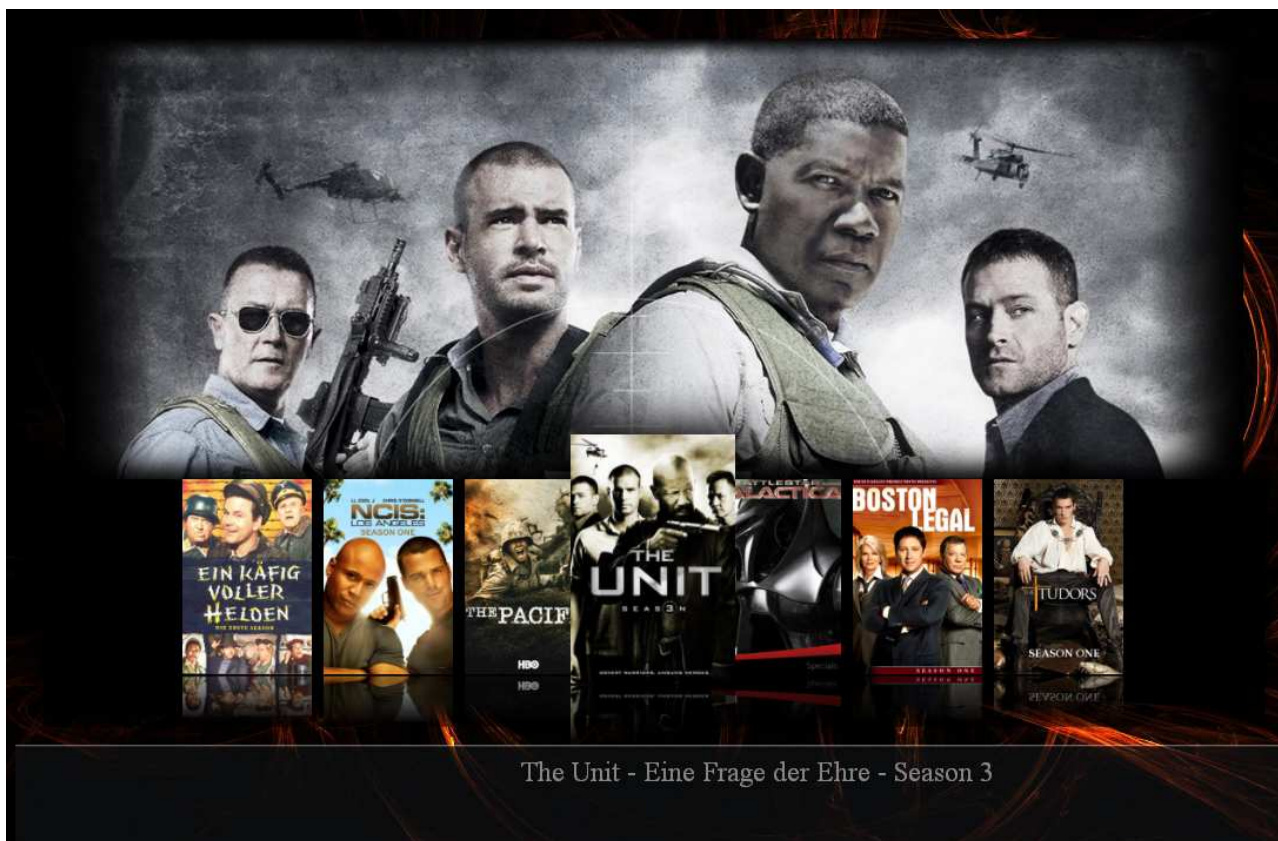
```
<!-- Redefined variables that you can change.-->  
<xsl:variable name="use-sliding">true</xsl:variable>
```

### I don't want the number of movies shown on right side!?

Check this setting:

```
<!-- true/false to see the number of movies on redefined indexes. -->  
<xsl:variable name="redefined-counter">false</xsl:variable>
```

### Will you be able to use the redefined TV wall only?



With version 1.18 you can activate "Redefined" index view for tv-shows or SET indexes by changing skin-options.xml to:

```
<xsl:variable name="tv-banners">redefined</xsl:variable>  
<xsl:variable name="tv-banners-set">redefined</xsl:variable>
```

## ----- DETAIL PAGES -----

### How can I change between plot and extras on the detail view?

As standard the RED/GREEN key will switch between plot pages or multi parts. LEFT and RIGHT switch between plot, extra, bonus, trailer and multipart if needed.

If you want the watchbar off as standard set the skin-options.xml:

```
<xsl:variable name="WatchBar">false</xsl:variable>
```

With the MENU/TAB key you can toggle on/off the watchbar.

### I don't like this keys, can I change it?

Yes, use the skin-options.xml settings:

```
<!-- TVID buttons for movie detail page. Change it, if you want to use other than the colored keys -->
<xsl:variable name="watchbar-key-up">RED</xsl:variable>
<xsl:variable name="watchbar-key-down">GREEN</xsl:variable>
<xsl:variable name="watchbar-key-left">LEFT</xsl:variable>
<xsl:variable name="watchbar-key-right">RIGHT</xsl:variable>

<!-- TVID button to toggle watchbar on/off on movie detail page. -->
<xsl:variable name="watchbar-key-toggle">TAB</xsl:variable>
```

### What about more options if I want show certification or I don't want to show the runtime?

You can change a lot of fields to unify your lowlist detail page. You can change the shown number of subtitles, audiotracks, actors, writers and genres:

```
<!-- Show year and/or country and/or rating and/or top250 on lowlist details top bar-->
<!-- You should only enable two of the three options or else the top bar may wrap and break the skin.-->
<xsl:variable name="lowlist-country">true</xsl:variable>
<xsl:variable name="lowlist-year">true</xsl:variable>
<xsl:variable name="lowlist-top250">false</xsl:variable>
<xsl:variable name="lowlist-certification">true</xsl:variable>

<!-- Change to true/false to enable/disable display on lowlist mode -->
<xsl:variable name="lowlist-runtime">true</xsl:variable>
<xsl:variable name="lowlist-multipart">true</xsl:variable>
<xsl:variable name="lowlist-subtitles">true</xsl:variable>
<xsl:variable name="lowlist-audiotracks">true</xsl:variable>
<xsl:variable name="lowlist-genre">true</xsl:variable>

<!-- Change the number of shown subtitles and audiotracks in lowlist mode -->
<xsl:variable name="lowlist-maxSub">2</xsl:variable>
<xsl:variable name="lowlist-maxAudio">2</xsl:variable>

<!-- Change the number of shown actors in lowlist mode -->
<xsl:variable name="lowlist-maxActors">4</xsl:variable>
<xsl:variable name="lowlist-maxWriters">2</xsl:variable>
<xsl:variable name="lowlist-maxGenre">3</xsl:variable>
```



## ----- TV SHOWS -----

### What view options for tvshow index are possible?

You can choose between the following options: 8 banners, 12 banners, 14 banners or no banners

To enable change the option:

```
<xsl:variable name="tv-banners">true</xsl:variable>
```

"true" = 8 banners, "false" = no banners, "12" or "14" are for 12 or 14 banners.

With tv-banners = false the tv shows will shown as normal covers view like the movie wall option. If you don't want to show tv sets as banners you must set this option to false:

```
<xsl:variable name="tv-banners-set">false</xsl:variable>
```

For all banner options you must also pound/unpound the proper lines in the skin-properties:

```
##### TV BANNERS CONTROL #####

# 0 BANNERS (USE THUMBNAIls) - works *only* for 'false' for "tv-banners" and "tv-banners-
set" in skin-options.xsl
# Set this to equal whatever you're using for mjb.nbThumbnailsPerPage above. (ex: 27, 12,
48, 17)
# Make sure you've pounded out all other instances of mjb.nbTvThumbnailsPerPage,
banners.width, and banners.height below
#mjb.nbTvThumbnailsPerPage=27
#banners.width=758
#banners.height=140

# 8 BANNERS - works *only* for 'true' for "tv-banners" and "tv-banners-set" in skin-
options.xsl
#banners.width=557
#banners.height=103
#mjb.nbTvThumbnailsPerPage=8

# 12 BANNERS - works *only* for '12' for "tv-banners" and "tv-banners-set" in skin-
options.xsl
banners.width=587
banners.height=108
mjb.nbTvThumbnailsPerPage=12

# 14 BANNERS - works *only* for '14' for "tv-banners" and "tv-banners-set" in skin-
options.xsl
#banners.width=659
#banners.height=121
#mjb.nbTvThumbnailsPerPage=14
(settings for 12 banners enabled)
```

## Can I have centred covers for tv show sets?



To enable it check this setting in skin.properties:

```
gt.set.row=3  
gt.set.align=center
```

*gt.set.row=3* will set the covers to the third row of the index. If you use a 2 row index you should only set it "2".

*gt.set.align* could be left, center or right.

## What options do I have for tv show details?

You can press the INFO key to switch on/off the season summary infos. If your remote didn't have an INFO key, you can give it an other TVID in the skin-options.xml:

```
<xsl:variable name="lowlist-tvshowbutton">INFO</xsl:variable>
```

## What about the playlist feature for tv shows?

The playlist feature can be enabled/disabled in the skin-options.xml too:

```
<xsl:variable name="TVPlaylist">true</xsl:variable>
```

With TVPlaylist=false you'll start the tv episodes by pressing ENTER or PLAY key on your remote. After the end of the episode you'll get back to the season detail page. With TVPlaylist=true the PLAY key will start the single episode. The ENTER key starts a playlist with all episodes starting from the selected one.

### **Can I have a reversed episode list?**

No, actually not.

### **What about a random tv episode?**

You can activate it with the setting in skin-options.xml:

```
<xsl:variable name="tv-random-episode">true</xsl:variable>
```

Every time you enter the tv show detail page or switch between the episodes a new random episode will be defined. Navigate to the "Random Episode" link and hit ENTER to start play. After end of the episode you'll return to tv show detail page. Before you can start a new random episode you need to switch between 2 other episodes.

### **Can I use the normal AEON detail and tvshow page?**

No, actually not with all features. They will work with the original skin and features. There will be a later version that support this pages and the new features too.

## **----- OVERSCAN OPTION -----**

### **There's a texture gap at the top and the bottom of my detail view, what do I have to change?**

Increase this value, 55 should be the maximum (10 seems to be a good value for C-200, other users reported they need 55 for fit to screen:

```
<xsl:variable name="lowlist-overscan">40</xsl:variable>
```

if the box texture doesn't fit to the dimmed textures you can increase/decrease this value:

```
<xsl:variable name="lowlist-overscan-offset">0</xsl:variable>
```

### **I only see half of the title bar and half of the flags at the bottom, how to fit to my screen?**

Decrease this value, 0 should be the minimum (for A/C-200 it seems 10 is a good value):

```
<xsl:variable name="lowlist-overscan">40</xsl:variable>
```

## **----- PC MENU OPTION -----**

With the release of r1.18 the skin will show a menu with LEFT/RIGHT UP/DOWN or NEXT/PREV buttons. If you don't want it you can disable it in skin-options.xml

```
<xsl:variable name="use-pcmenu">>false</xsl:variable>
```
